ADVISORY: President Obama to Travel to Oklahoma

WASHINGTON, DC – On Wednesday, July 15, the President will travel to Durant High School in Durant, OK, where he will deliver remarks on expanding economic opportunity for communities across the country, including the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma. Following his remarks, the President will depart Durant and travel to the Oklahoma City area, where he will remain overnight. On Thursday, July 16, the President will visit the El Reno Federal Correctional Institution outside of Oklahoma City, marking the first visit by a sitting President to a federal prison. While there, he will meet with law enforcement officials and inmates and conduct an interview for a Vice documentary that will air in the fall about the realities of our criminal justice system.

The arrival and departure of Air Force One on Wednesday, July 15 in Denison, TX are open to pre-credentialed media, but closed to the public. There will be travel pool coverage of the President's arrival and departure in Durant, OK. The President's remarks at Durant High School are open to pre-credentialed media, but closed to the public. The President's remarks will also be streamed live at whitehouse.gov/live.

The arrival of Air Force One in Oklahoma City, OK on Wednesday, July 15 and the departure of Air Force One on Thursday, July 16 are open to pre-credentialed media, but closed to the public. There will be travel pool coverage of the President's visit to the El Reno Federal Correctional Institution.

Live Truck Parking: All live trucks must arrive no later than 11:30 AM. Parking will be directed on site. Late arrivals will not be accommodated.

General media parking: Across the Street from Fire Station along frontage road

Media Pre-Set: 11:00 AM – 11:30 AM Any media who wish to pre-set equipment must do so no later than 11:30 AM. Live trucks MUST cable into the site during this time. Media pre-set is strongly encouraged for outlets with heavy equipment and large amounts of gear. Media will not have access to their equipment during security sweeps from 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM.

Throw (Distance from riser to aircraft): 150 feet

Cable Run (Distance from live trucks to riser): 350 feet

Media Entrance: Media should enter through the southwest entrance to Durant High School.

Media Pre-Set: 8:30 AM – 9:30 AM. Any media who wish to pre-set equipment must be at the southwest entrance to Durant High School no later than 8:15 AM. Live trucks MUST cable in to the event site during this time. Media pre-set is strongly encouraged for outlets with heavy equipment and large amounts of gear. Media will not have access to their equipment during security sweeps from 9:30 AM – 12:30 PM.

Live Truck Parking: All live trucks must arrive no later than 8:15 AM to the southwest entrance to Durant High School. Parking will be directed on site. Late arrivals will not be accommodated.
